Stage 1- Registration

• Read British Equestrian (BEF) National para classification rules and check your eligibility here.

Think you're eligible?

• Complete and return the National classification registration form and consent form to Felicity Towers at BEF.

Registration form must be completed in full and medical evidence supplied for your application to be assessed.

- Completed forms are distributed and assessed by one of BEF's National Classification Working Groups.
- Riders will be contacted by BEF via email with results of the application, this can take a minimum of six weeks.

Stage 2- Athlete Evaluation

- Riders eligible to have an Athlete Evaluation will be give the opportunity to book an appointment at the of the Classification Hubs held throughout the UK.
- BEF will contact you via email to confirm the results of your Athlete Evaluation.
- It can take a minimum of three weeks to receive your results, depending on the nature of your application.
